

2/21/12. 68 y.o. female admitted 2/20/2012 for acute pneumonia, acute hypoxemia, congestion, and SOB. V/S 98.4 T, 90 P, 22 R, 118/72 R BP, 7/10 Pain. Alert and oriented x 3. PERRLA, 2 mm. No slurring of speech. On low sodium diet, feeds self without assistance, appetite good, ate 75% of breakfast. Light headed when turning head from side to side. Grips equal. Upper extremities normal mobility. Lung sounds clear, bilateral and anterior and posterior, respiratory rhythm/effort normal, 92% O2 Sat, receiving O2/5L. Pain on lower right side of lung & left side down to the leg. Heart sounds regular, normal S1 and S2 noted without murmur. Surgical incision on lower back from previous back surgery. Bowel sounds present in all 4 quadrants with tenderness on left side. Last BM 2 days ago. Urinating on own without difficulty or complaints of pain/burning, output 350 cc. Up to chair in morning w/o assistance. Right leg weak +1, left leg strong +5, right foot toes are numb & tingling on right leg when touched, left leg normal mobility, no edema. PPP bilat - DP - L+1 & R+2, PT - +2. Right leg cool and dry, left foot warm and dry. Skin turgor instant. Capillary refill to bilat upper/lower extremities <3 secs. Shift intake 435 cc, output 350 cc. Fluid balance +85 cc for this shift.-----E. Matsko, KSU SN
